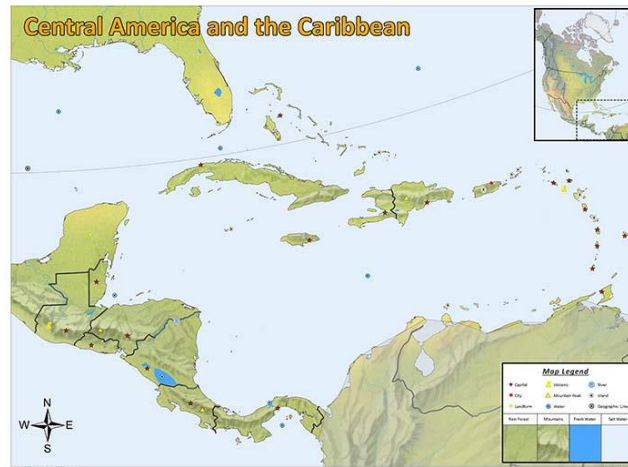
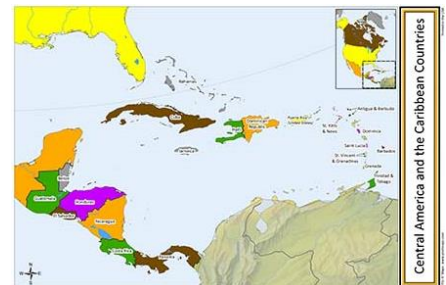


Commands for Caribbean Nations and Puerto Rico (Central America)
